Message from the Chair

Welcome to Fleet and District U3A. By joining, you have become part of a national organisation of U3As, affiliated to the Third Age Trust, where local groups like ours provide opportunities for older adults to come together to develop their existing interests and to learn new skills. We don't study for qualifications; we just enjoy taking part and making new friends.

The 'Third Age' comes from a French idea, where the First Age is your childhood and education, the Second Age is your working life and bringing up children, and the Third Age is where you make the most of your leisure time, have fun and help others.

Fleet U3A was formed in 1994 and we have grown into one of the largest U3As in the country. We are all volunteers. We share our knowledge and expertise with fellow members, certain that we will benefit from others' skills and experience in other fields. Let us know if you have a skill you would like to share or an interest you would like to develop with like-minded people. Please also look for opportunities to join or support the leadership team of the groups you join: there's a lot that goes on behind the scenes.

Most groups meet in the daytime during the working week. We mostly keep to school terms. We have gradually returned to our traditional pre-pandemic pattern of meetings, and are enjoying the chance to socialise in person. We do still suggest that members do not attend if they are experiencing cold or flu-like symptoms.

There is usually a venue hire fee each term and sometimes additional charges for professional tutors, trips, external speakers or materials. Our flagship event is our Monthly Meeting with a guest speaker and a chance to meet informally, held on the third Wednesday in the month. We also run members' coffee meetings, an Open Morning in April and our AGM in November.

Fleet U3A has charity status and is governed by a hard-working and dedicated committee which meets monthly. It is a big job to manage an organisation as large as ours so we are always on the lookout for help. Some key post holders will be stepping down in 2024, so opportunities are sure to arise.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF FLEET AND DISTRICT U3A MEMBERSHIP

(As shown on the membership application form)

CODE OF CONDUCT

U3A members are expected to conduct themselves in line with the Movement's Guiding Principles.

Specifically:

-  Members are expected to know, follow and promote the Principles of the u3a Movement at every opportunity.
-  Members must always act in the best interests of Fleet u3a and the u3a Movement, strive to uphold its reputation and never do anything which could bring their own, another u3a or the u3a Movement into disrepute or expose it to undue risk.
-  Members are expected to use Fleet u3a's resources responsibly and only to further its stated charitable objects/purposes.
-  Members are expected to reflect the current organisational policy of Fleet u3a, regardless of whether it conflicts with their personal views.
-  Members are expected to abide by Fleet u3a's procedures and practices.
-  Members are expected to treat each other with dignity and respect at all times.

PROCESS FOR JOINING A GROUP

Group Enrolment Morning is organised so that members can ask to join the group(s) of their choice. If a group you wish to join is currently full it may be possible for you to join a waiting list, please ask the Group Leader. When joining a group, the leader will first need to see your **current** membership card and will then add your name and contact information to the register. The dates and times that groups meet is shown in the Programme. Please always be sure to inform your group leader(s) AND the membership secretary (memsec@fleetu3a.org.uk) if you change your phone number and/or e-mail address.

If you cannot attend Enrolment Morning, please contact the Group Leader of the group(s) you wish to join **before** attending a meeting. All the dates for group meetings are shown in this programme. After you have enrolled with the Group Leader, then please turn up on the dates shown.

When you attend your first meeting, you must show the Group Leader your **current** membership card. It is recommended that both sides of the card be completed, the reverse to show ICE (in case of emergency) details.

Please Note: It is not acceptable to 'turn up' at a group meeting without first registering with the Group Leader; all GL contact details are included in this programme.

Carers accompanying members are welcome free of charge at all meetings.

FEES PAYABLE

Fees members have to pay to belong to Groups include:-

1. Venue Contribution Fee (charges per session given on page 6). All venue contribution fees will be collected at the beginning of each term as the venue has to be paid for regardless of whether individual members attend.
2. Professional Fees for Groups with the +P annotation (e.g. £30 - £50 per term)
3. Other Fees for Groups with the +O annotation (e.g. extra venue costs, materials, etc.)

Normally fees are charged up front on a termly basis and are always non-refundable. In cases of hardship, at the discretion of a GL, the fees may be paid by instalments.

Note: "Taster" sessions may be available on a one-off basis. If you would like to try a Group before joining, please contact the relevant group leader.

GROUP LEADERS' INFORMATION

Group leaders must inform the Venues Secretary (venues@fleetu3a.org.uk) as quickly as possible if there is a need to change or cancel any meeting so that we can try to minimise any venue charges that might apply.

PROCESS FOR STARTING A NEW GROUP

If you feel you would like to see a new group formed, please contact the Group Leadership Liaison (GLL) (email: groups@fleetu3a.org.uk).

The GLL and Newsletter Editor will then advertise the proposal in the Monthly Newsletter to assess interest level and viability, after which the 'formal' establishment of the group will proceed to the next step if sufficient members come forward.

The interested members will need to agree on the meeting frequency (e.g. weekly, bi-weekly or monthly) and day, time and duration for the meetings.

The GLL will liaise with the Venues Secretary to see if a suitable venue can be booked.

Some groups may wish to meet in private homes, or public spaces e.g. cafes or pubs. These meetings, when approved, will also be covered by U3A Insurance.

Official Committee approval will be requested by the GLL for the formation of any new group, approval is normally a formality if sufficient members and a venue can be found.
